Information for Authors

Editorial Policy

The main emphasis of the journal is based on research articles, review articles, case studies. Submissions are welcome from authors in disciplines serving child development or mental health. Each submitted paper is reviewed by experts in the field of the paper's content. In order to be published, a paper must conform to professional standards of the disciplines identified with its content.

Manuscript Submission

Details of the submission and review process can be found at www.ricd.go.th/cdmh. The editor and editorial board oversee manuscript reviews. Once a manuscript is submitted, an editor is assigned, and this editor makes the peer reviewer assignments. The entire process ordinarily takes 3 months, and revisions are often requested.

Corresponding authors who require assistance in submitting their manuscripts should contact the Editorial Office via the website, www.ricd.go.th/cdmh; or e-mail, cdmh2012@yahoo.com.

Manuscripts should be prepared in accordance with the instructions given there for preparing tables, figures, references and metrics. Abstracts should be followed. The editor is responsible for obtaining reviews and deciding on the disposition of all manuscripts (acceptance, rejection, or requests for revision).

Manuscript Preparation


- 1. The preferred length of manuscripts is 20 typed pages or less, but a somewhat greater length may be accepted, depending on the complexity and importance of the research.
- 2. The title page should carry the following information:
 - 1) Title, which should be concise but informative without using acronyms.

- 2) Authors, including first name, middle initial, and last name along with highest academic degree(s).
- 3) Institutional affiliation(s) of each author (use super-scripted numbers after each author's name, and a corresponding superscripted number before each institutional affiliation).
- 4) Email address.
- 3. A structured abstract should be no longer than 300 words, with writing sequence and include the following parts:

Objective (brief statement of the purpose of the study); Methods (summary of the participants, The design, samples selection, setting, measures, procedure); Results (primary findings of this work); and Conclusions (statement of implications of these data).

- 4. Keywords should be included. They are useful as a tool when researching for paper information from journals.
- 5. Introduction (Provide a context or background significance of this study. State the specific Purpose or research objective. Give only strictly pertinent references.)
- 6. Methods (Selection and description of participants; Identify the methods, apparatus, and procedures.); Statistics
- 7. Results: Present your results in logical sequence in the text, tables, and illustrations, giving the main or most important findings first. Tables and figures should each be numbered consecutively.
- 8. Discussion: Emphasize the new and important aspects of the study and the conclusions that follow from them.
- 9. Acknowledgements should be as brief as possible, in a separate section before the references, and not in the text or as footnotes.
- 10. References use APA style.
