Moving Forward from Chulalongkorn Medical Bulletin to Journal of Medical Bioscience

On behalf of the editorial board, we are pleased to announce the title change of Chulalongkorn Medical Bulletin (Chula Med Bull, CLMB; ISSN, 2651-2149) to Journal of Medical Bioscience (J Med Biosci, JMBS; ISSN, 2773-9996). From volume 3, issue number 2 in July 2021, the journal will be published under the new title Journal of Medical Bioscience with the same scope of publication as the former title. Chulalongkorn Medical Bulletin was launched in 2019 as the official journal of Faculty of Medicine Chulalongkorn University. Under its new name, Journal of Medical Bioscience continues to publish peer-reviewed, open access, and Thai-English-language scientific articles in the areas of basic, clinical, and translational research, studies of diagnostic accuracy, studies relating to behavioral, therapeutic, or epidemiological aspects of medicine, public health, environmental health, and health sciences.

With this editorial, a major transformation to Journal of Medical Bioscience is introduced. From July 1, 2021, an alteration to the journal will be a change of journal title. The new title will make the journal more acknowledgeable to both national and international biomedical community. The essential basis for renaming Chulalongkorn Medical Bulletin is not only to broaden the readership and expand the audience for the publication but also to improve the visibility and the quality of the journal. Furthermore, we welcome manuscripts from medical students, residents, as well as graduate students.

Publishing success at the beginning of a professional or research career could be essential in terms of encouraging future endeavor. Therefore, we seek eminent articles, of which a medical student is the primary author, which meet in research standards for an occasional “Student Section” of the journal. It will be appropriate for the student’s supervisor to be a co-author or corresponding author. The editorial board would like, therefore, to encourage the submission of any articles based on work carried out by students. The articles will be expected to meet the same standards for publication as other articles. The Student Section editor will ensure that feedback is given to students in positive ways and will provide assistance and encouragement for revision/resubmission where this is necessary. Where an article is rejected, however, the editor will pay prudent attention to the authors and provide encouragement for their future writing.

We are grateful to all the editorial board members for their contributions toward improving the journal quality. We gratefully acknowledged all of our authors for contributing their excellent work and all the reviewers for their professional and considerate input in assisting the journal to achieve its standards. The renewed title, Journal of Medical Bioscience, is a new commencement. We aspire that Journal of Medical Bioscience will contribute to the field of medical bioscience research, foster scientific communication, and collaborate among medical bioscience researchers both locally and globally.
